ENTRY CONDITIONS

- The proposal submitted with the entry form must comprise: a one page description of the work, a table of contents, an author biography, a comment on the targeted readership and two sample chapters. Please note that complete manuscripts will not be accepted.
- An indication of the proposed word length should be given (40,000 minimum and 90,000 maximum). Final word length will be subject to negotiation with the publisher.
- The proposal must be an original work, entirely by the entrant, written in English, and have contemporary Australian relevance. Fiction and academic theses will not be accepted. The work cannot be on submission with any other publisher.
- Entrants must be Australian citizens or residents of Australia. There is no age limit.
- The proposal must be in double-spaced type on A4 paper, and unbound, i.e. without any clips, staples, folders or any other form of binding material.
- Entrants must lodge their entry with an accompanying official entry form or the entry may be deemed ineligible for the prize.
- Entries must be lodged with an accompanying cheque or money order to cover the entry fee of \$20.00. Cheques to be made out to Allen & Unwin Pty Ltd.
- Entries must be lodged by close of business, 1 September 2009.
- An acknowledgement will be sent to each entrant on receipt of entry.
- The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The winner/s will be announced in December 2009.
- Allen & Unwin will publish the winning entry, and will have exclusive worldwide publishing rights to it, and to any other entry it feels is of sufficient merit.
- The judges shall have the discretion to divide the prize equally between authors of entries they consider of equal merit. If, in their opinion, no entry is worthy of the prize, no winner shall be chosen. No entrant may win the prize in successive years.
- Proposals will not be returned.
- Each entrant is required to sign the entry form, which binds them to the above conditions of entry.
